Description:

Painted random coursed limestone walls with dressed quoins. Corrugated calvanized iron cable ended roof with protruding attic room. Double hung sash windows. Timber extension at rear of building. Three storey buildir of Georgian proportions.

Built for David Simpson and 'still the only three-storeyed building in the town.' (J. Murdoch and H. Parker). Endured commercial vicissitudes till 1888 when bought by J. & G. Thomson. Business was good in later years, and grain would be brought from as far away as Robe, Kingston and Goroke (Vic.). J. Thomson also had a mill at Wolseley by 1909. The Naracoorte mill ceased business in the 1930's.


