


wetlands and Buloke woodland communities each benefit from on-ground protection, improvements, surveys and monitoring, and are supported through community engagement.

Re-vegetation in the Subtropical and temperate coastal saltmarsh community is managed by the Coorong, Lower Lakes and Murray Mouth project.

Changes in the extent have not been recorded for any of the ecological communities since they were categorised as threatened.
