Acroptilon repe

AIM: To destroy plants and prevent any further seed set

Control Options	Chemical	Rate	Comments
Spot Spray	Tordon <sup>®</sup> 75D	1.3L/100L	Soil Residual. Do not use near desirable vegetation. Do not apply near susceptible crops.
	Glyphosate 360 + Pulse <sup>®</sup>	1L/100L 200ml/100L	Suppression only. Repeat application as required.
	Dicamba 500	600ml/100L	Spot spray to point of run off.
Boom Spray	Dicamba 500	8.8L/ha	Boom spray and burn off stubble.
