*Reseda lutea*

**AIM: To destroy plants and prevent any further seed set**

Control Options	Chemical	Rate	Comments
Spot Spray	Tordon <sup>®</sup> 75D	650ml/100L	Spot spray before flowering. Soil residual do not use near desirable vegetation or in waterways. Do not apply near susceptible crops. May require repeat applications
Boom Spray	Ally <sup>®</sup>	7g/ha	Spray actively growing plant up to flowering. Repeat treatment may be required.
	Agritone <sup>®</sup> 750	1.45L/ha	
	MCPA 500	2.1L/ha
