AIM: To destroy plants and prevent any further seed set

Control Options	Chemical	Rate	Comments
Spot Spray	Tordon <sup>®</sup> 75D	1.3L/100L	Soil residual. Do not use near desirable vegetation or in waterways. Do not apply near susceptible crops. May require repeat applications.
	Weedmaster® Duo	500ml/100L	Apply from late July to September when plants are in rosette to flowering stage
Boom Spray	Weedmaster <sup>®</sup> Duo	1.5L/ha	Apply from late July to September when plants are in rosette to flowering stage
	Broadside™	1L/ha	Apply when at 2 to 4 leaf stage.
