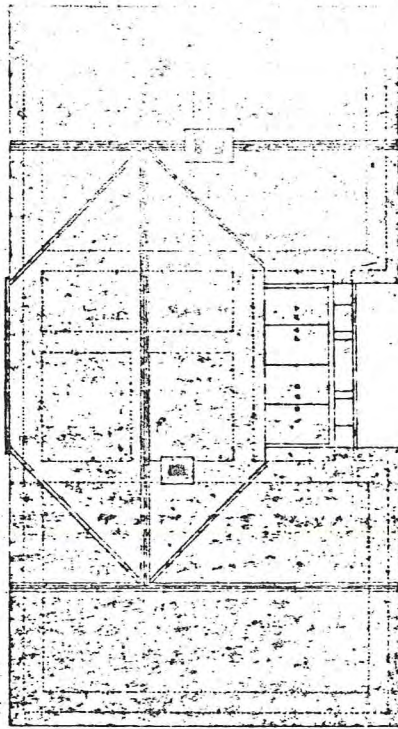
FRONT ELEVATION



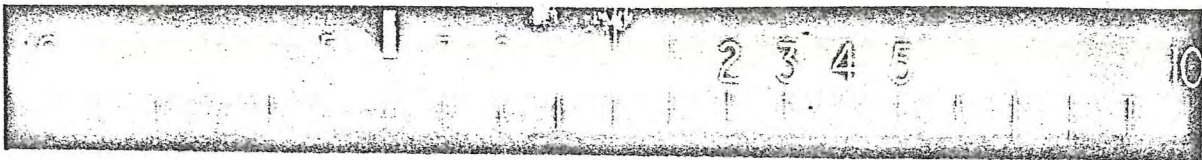
BACK ELEVATION



FLOOR PLAN



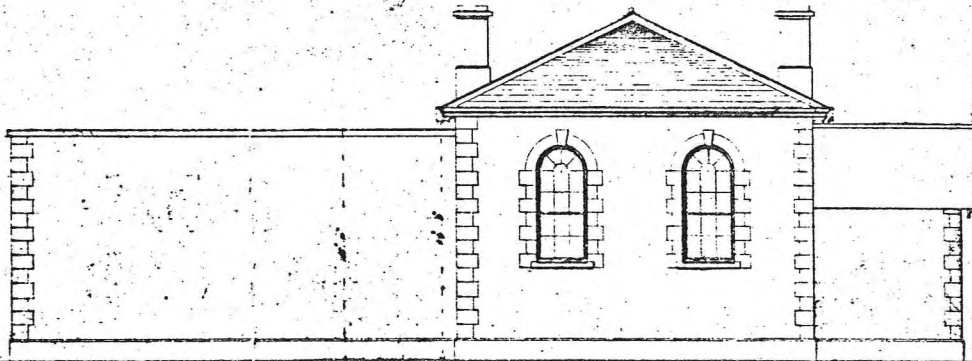

ELEVATION

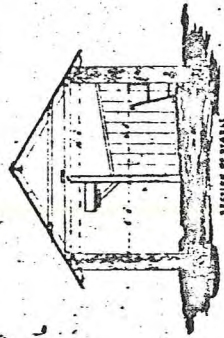


SECTION OF STABLE

Report from Manager of Waterworks for Half-year ended June, 1859.

Waterworks Office, Adelaide, 25th July, 1859.

Sir—In compliance with the instructions contained in your letter of the 1st instant, I have the honor to report upon the progress of the Waterworks during the six months ending on the 30th ultimo.

The changes which took place in the engineering branch of this Department towards the end of 1858, for a time put a stop to the advancement of works; so that, when the late Commissioners vacated office in December last, under the provisions of the Act No. 17 of 1858, the only contracts in progress were—1. The Messrs. Levi's contract for supplying pipes. 2. Mr. Gouge's contract for the dam-head at the reservoir. 3. Mr. Horwood's contract for a lathe. 4. Mr. Phillips's contract for the transport to the Gorge of 300 tons of 21-inch pipe.

Levi's contract is still in progress, and the contractors are now five months beyond the time fixed for the completion of their shipments.

Mr. Gouge's contract was brought to a close on 9th April.

Mr. Horwood's lathe was finished on 27th January; and Mr Phillips's contract for carting was satisfactorily completed on 28th February.

For the first two months of the present year, the Engineer's time was so fully occupied in attending to the details of existing works, and of the general conduct of the affairs of the Department which temporarily devolved on him, that he was unable to bring forward for public competition any new contracts.

The arrangements of the Government, which came into force on the 1st March, relieved him from all duties except those of a professional character, and since then additional works have been undertaken, as follows—1. Alterations to buildings at the storage yard. 2. Carting to their sites 1,000 tons of 21-inch pipe. 3. Road at the storage yard. 4. Laying 21-inch main. 5. Pulling down river weir. 6. Making a deviation from reservoir to the Glynde Inn. 7. Carting 700 tons of 18-inch main through the above deviation. 8. Additions to reservoir.

The alteration to buildings at the storage yard has rendered them available for offices, and effect a saving of £125 a year for rent. The repairs have been of a plain but useful character, and will be sufficient for the requirements of the Waterworks Department for some years.

The carting of the 21-inch pipes has proceeded in a most satisfactory manner, and there has not been a single pipe broken in 1,300 tons.

The road at the storage yard enables carters to enter and load pipes in all weathers, and has cost, including materials for repairs, £31 7s. 2d.

The laying of the 21-inch main is proceeding well; about half-mile has been permanently fixed, and the excavation is being pushed on satisfactorily. The contract has been taken at a low price.

In obedience to your instructions, the pulling down of the river weir has been let by contract, and a considerable portion thereof removed. It is unnecessary now to detail the facts which have so far been brought to light, because they will form the subject of a special report, but it is proper to state that the structure (if such it can be called) proves to be infinitely worse than was generally expected, and there is the most positive evidence that the original

## (B.)—REPORT FROM SUPERINTENDENT OF GOOLWA TRAMWAY.

Railway Office, Goolwa, January 10th, 1861.

Sir—I have the honor to forward, for the information of the Hon. the Commissioner of Public Works, my yearly report of the Port Elliot and Goolwa Tramway and the Port Elliot Waterworks, ending 31st December, 1860.

The enclosed abstract of receipts during the year will show a balance over the expenditure of £359 16s. 2d.

The river trade, on the whole, has been brisker, and much improved. The quantity of wool brought down has exceeded any previous year; the principal part of which has passed over the line to Port Elliot, and chiefly shipped for Melbourne. The *Sturt* has taken a good number through the Murray-mouth for Adelaide, and the *Ruby* to Melbourne—which has, of course, operated against the tramway.

I have again the pleasure and satisfaction to report that there has not been the least accident on the line since I had the honor to report last—this making the eighth year since the commencement of the line, and the sixth since it was opened for general traffic, during which time there has not been any accident whatever.

The two horses working the goods traffic are in good working condition, but their strength has not been quite sufficient to keep the work under this last two months. I have had to borrow horses to assist them, but we are now getting over the wool season, therefore I think that the two horses will be able to do the present work on the line.

The horses working the passenger traffic are getting so old and infirm that they must be turned out, for I am afraid every day to see them falling under the carriage. The horse that I bought some time ago has been lame and not able to work; but he is now better, and I work him a little to assist the old horses. I am afraid that I shall have to apply for authority to buy two more horses before long.

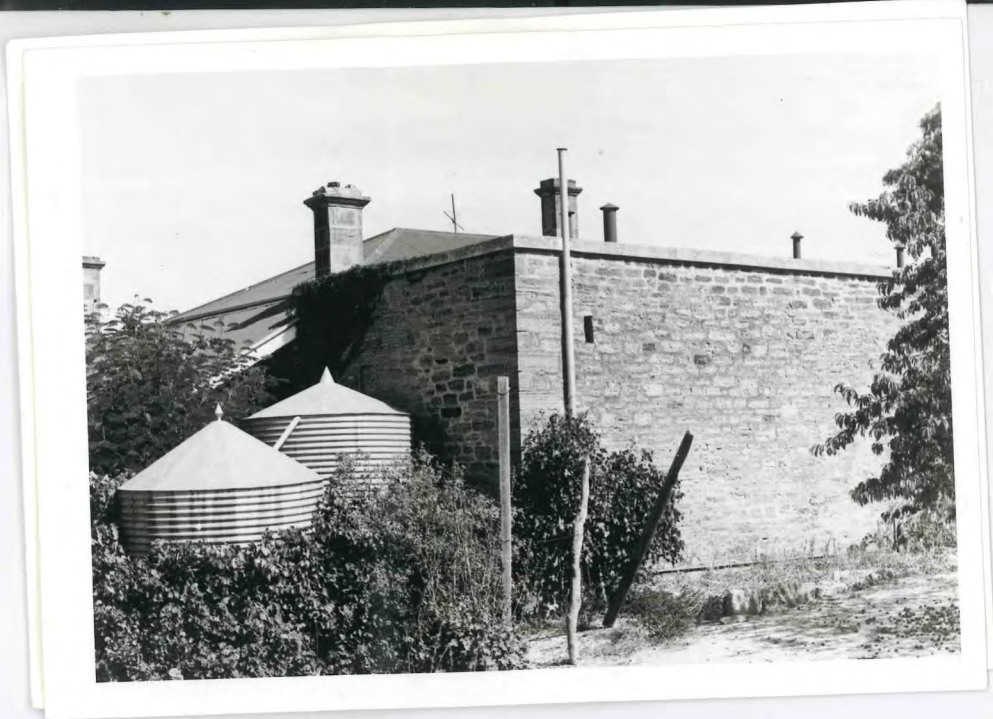
