**Description:**

Random coursed stonework with stone quoins and dressed surrounds. Steeply pitched slate roof. Flat sheet iron clad spire (30.00 metres high). Pointed arched Gothic stained glass windows. Entrance porch has red dolomite columns. Small buttresses top spire and east elevation. Typical Gothic style church with Gothic detailing top windows and doors.

Known at first, like its predecessor of 1858, as 'The Kirk'. Benefitted much from the generosity of the Robertsons. Building restored in the mid-1950's, after the steeple had been condemned.

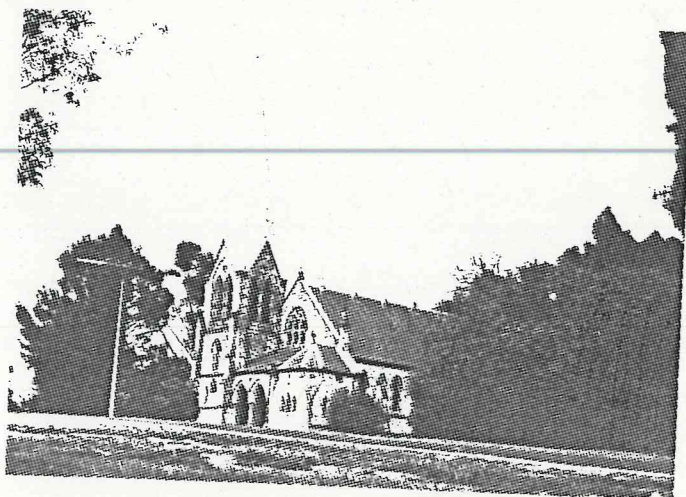

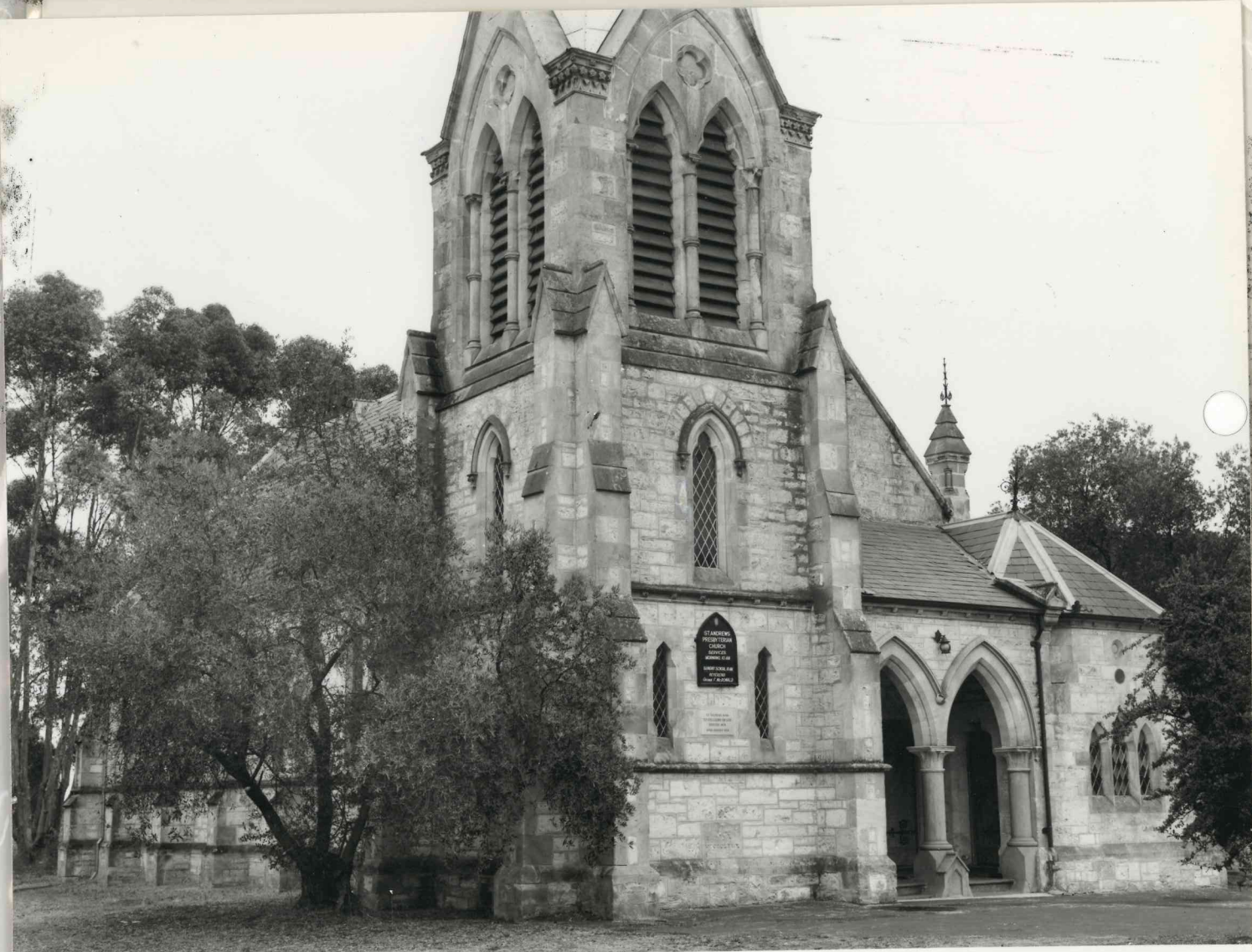

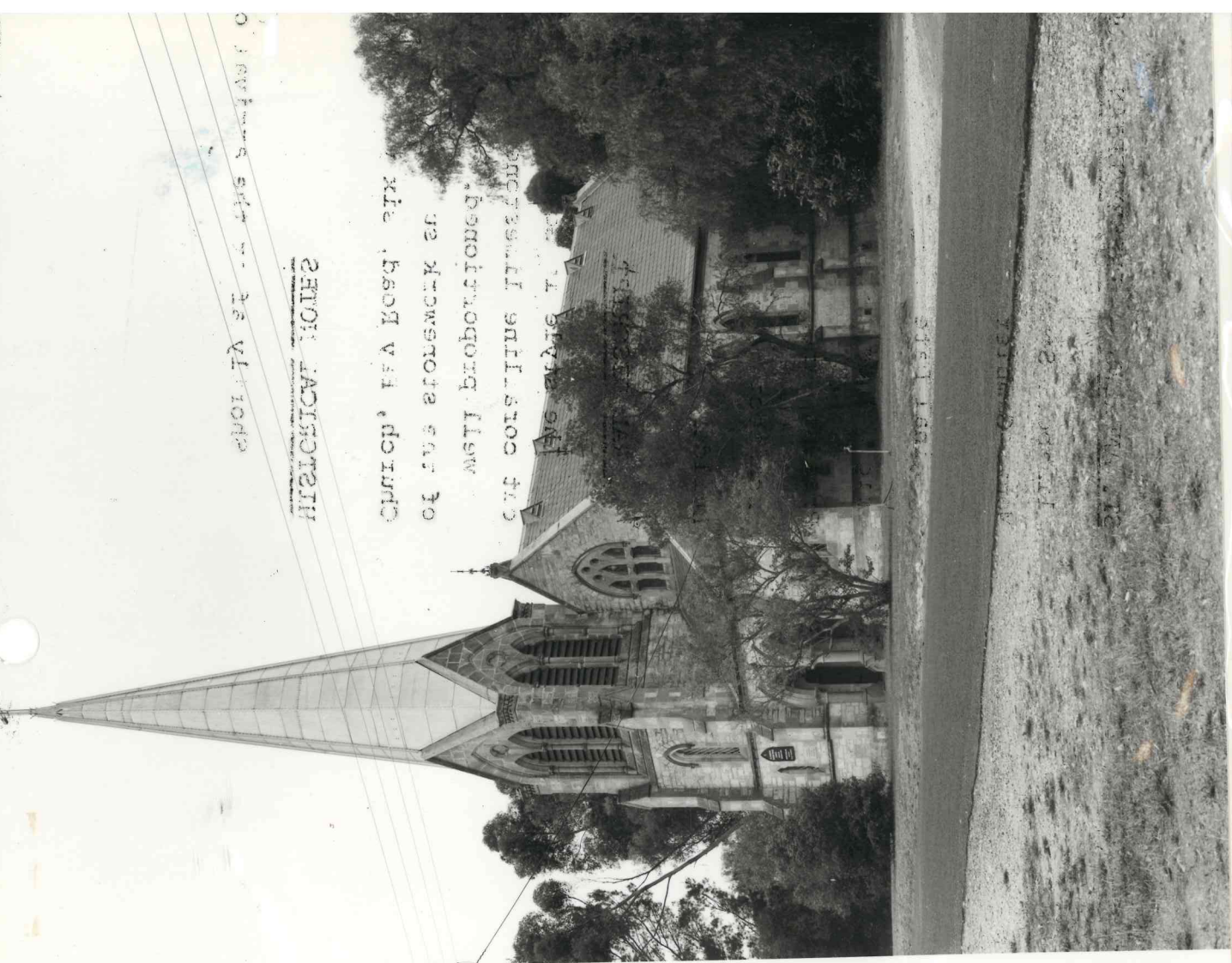
