Built of local freestone with sand stock brick porch corner piers, and window surrounds and chimneys, a feature of this house is the porch with round arches to the sides and front entrance door and a three centred arch to the front. The steps and landing are of Willunga slate, the roof of corrugated iron and the windows with fine glazing bars.

The Olives was built in 1859-60, an HISTORICAL SUMMARY: extension of an earlier dwelling. It became the home of William Sharrad and his families. Sharrad was part of the first wave of settlement in the Yankalilla area. By 1871 Sharrad had acquired 320 acres. He later left the area and died at Norwood in 1893.

An example of an unusual design HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE: of an agricultural dwelling. The building's history and subsequent restoration have given it a National heritage




