RECOMMENDATION: State

Description:

Two storey limestone with dressed stone quoins and stone chimney. Corrugated galvanized iron hipped roof. Double hung sash windows. Central arched opening, through which 'Coffee Pot' railway engines hauled produce to and from the jetty. Small balcony on first floor with cast iron lacework over central opening. Internally there is a two storey space with mezzanine floor. Internal timbers are of oregon. Part of the front elevation used to be a shop.

The new port had four shipping agents, including F.M.H. Bevilacqua. A branch line of the railway ran into the store. The store was the first meeting place of the Beachport District Council.

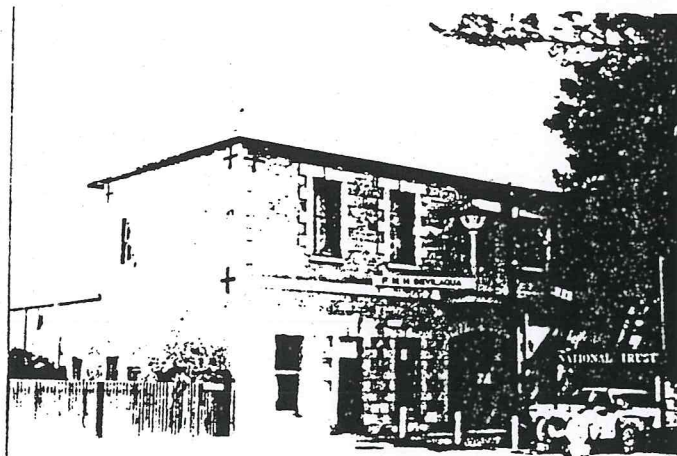
