

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE: Build 1873 as premises of the Bank of Adelaide at a cost of more than \$4000. Property purchased by the Freemasons in 1898 for \$1125, resold to W.R. Lewis, Solicitor, in 1902. Purchased by the Union Bank in 1928. The first branch of the Bank of Adelaide was opened in Cawler on 12th March 1866. The Union Bank, which had taken over the Bank of S.A. in 1892, previously occupied premises next to the Southend Hotel, now the offices of Rudall & Rudall. Italianate building, slate pointed with stucco corner blockings and dressings. Hipped roof with wide overhanging eaves with attractive brackets. Italianate villa style, bluestone building pointed and lined with stucco corner blockings and dressings. A hipped roof has wide overhanging eaves with attractive brackets.

The S.A. Banking Company opened a branch in Gawler in 1857. It then became the Bank of S.A. In 1892, the Union Bank took over and the Bank of S.A. disappeared. Later this became the Australia and New Zealand Ban Good condition. First Manager - Mr. Alexander Grace Building erected and opened 4th April, 1859.


