Page 369.—Delete the three exclamation marks before the combinations in *Machaerina*.

Pages 369, 371 and 374.—Correct the specific epithets in the index for the names to read: *Luzula rhadina*, *Narcissus tazetta*, and *Pimelea curviflora*.

The following species, not listed in Black's Fl. S. Austral. (ed. 2), the occurrence of which had been reported for South Australia earlier, were inadvertently omitted from the Supplement:

**Bromus rigidus* Roth (1790).—Meningie. [See Williams, S. Austral. Naturalist 32 (1957) 24.]

**Paspalum vaginatum* Swartz (1788).—In swamps and irrigation ditches near the mouth of the River Murray. [See Williams, Trans. Roy. Soc. S. Austral. 76 (1953) 51.]

**Vulpia membranacea* (L.) Dum.—Colonizing loose sands in the vicinity of Lake Albert (Meningie). [See Williams, S. Austral. Naturalist 30 (1956) 43.]

Leptospermum glabrescens Wakefield (1955).—Square Waterhole; Lake Bonney. [See Wakefield, Viet. Naturalist 72 (1955) 43.]

Melaleuca hamulosa Turcz.—Eyre Peninsula: Wudinna Hill. [See Ising, Trans. Roy. Soc. S. Austral. 81 (1958) 168.]

Goodenia lobata Ising (1958).—Far North: Evelyn Downs, south-west of Oodnadatta. [See Ising, Trans. Roy. Soc. S. Austral. 81 (1958) 169.]

Johnson]; **Fumaria vaillantii* Lois.; *Geranium potentilloides* L'Hér. ex DC.; *G. retrorsum* L'Hér. ex DC.; *G. solanderi* Carolin; *Harmsiodoxa puberula* Shaw; **Lavatera assurgentiflora* Kellogg; *Marsilea angustifolia* R.Br.; *Pomaderris forrestiana* FvM.; *Ptilotus blackii* Benl; *Thelymitra matthewsii* Cheeseman; *Velleia arguta* R.Br. [det. R. C. Carolin]; *Waitzia citrina* (Benth.) Steetz.
