Description:

Pug and pine cottage with gable ended corrugated galvanised iron roof. Hessian ceilings. Several stone chimneys. Corrugated galvanised iron lean-to.

Historical Summary:

First owners Slaters. Present owner D. Turner. The Slaters who took up this land in 1884, travelled from Laura by bullock cart. Living in a tent for eighteen months, the home was, in the first instance, built as a two roomed dwelling.

Significance:

One of the earlier homes representing closer settlement in the area.

Random rubble and rendered stonework cottage with gable ended corrugated galvanised iron roof and brick chimney. Convex verandah with simple timber posts. Multi-paned casement sash windows. Random rubble stone lean-to. Outbuilding alongside.

Historical Summary:

Carl and Annie Schubert moved to this district in 1908 and built their four roomed house for fifty pounds. In 1913 the property was sold to G. Spriggs.

Historical Summary:

The foundation stone was laid by Rev. C. Stolz on the 28th July 1928. It is reputed that a Mr. Tamke from Nuriootpa was responsible for the making of the altar. This was the second Lutheran church in the area.

Significance:

One of the most attractive Lutheran churches on the Eyre Peninsula and though isolated, is well maintained by its worshippers.

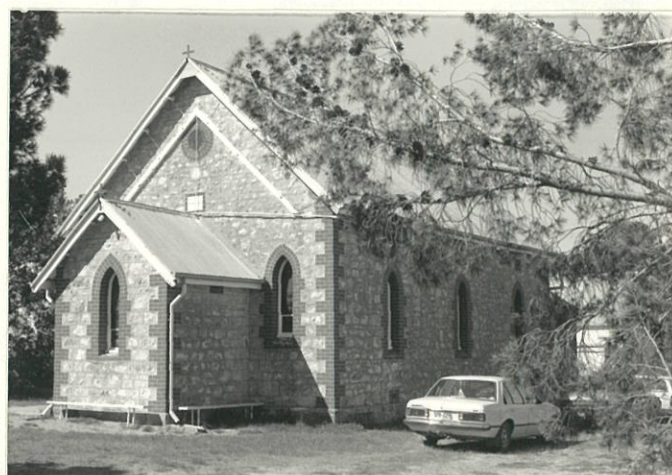

The memorial on the grave is to the memory of John Charles Darke, surveyor, who was killed by Aborigines whilst exploring in the area. He was buried close to where the tragedy occurred but before the plaque could be erected in 1910, the location of his grave had to be re-established.

Significance:

J. C. Darke is a significant part of Cleve's history, for he was exploring this region long before any other European pastoralist or farmer came to settle in the area.

Last used on 13 July, 1985 for a "Back to Darke Peak" celebration. It was the centre for most forms of entertainment, such as the visiting 'picture man'. It was the town's venue until 1958 when the new hall was built.

Significance:

Of more significance to the town than the later hall because it was the venue for most of the town's entertainment. The more modern hall does not have the same affection, mainly due to the impact of television and videos.

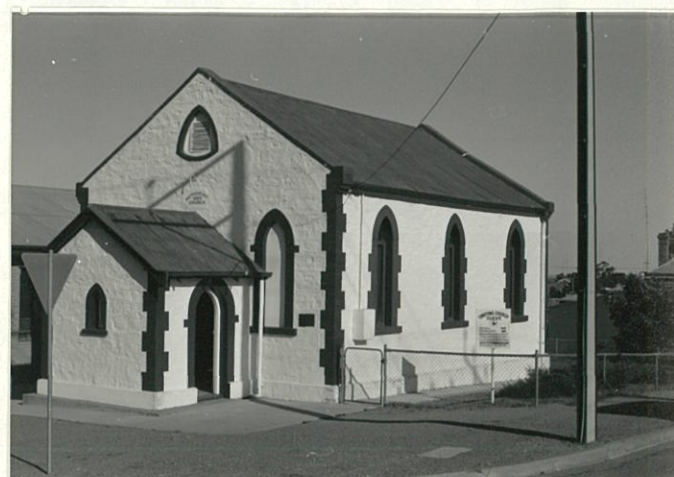

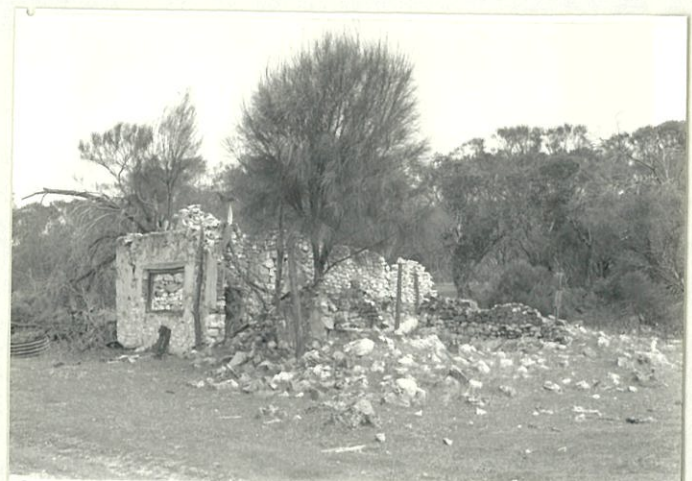
