First owner Betts. Ceased being a store in 1920 and is now used as a residence. William Henry Betts first settled at Streaky Bay in 1883. Eighteen months later he opened his store there. After 1888 he branched out, establishing shops at Fowlers Bay, Murat Bay (Ceduna), Eucla and Denial Bay. He was also involved in the first surveys in the district in 1884.

It is believed that the first pile for the jetty was driven in by a Miss Myers. It has had approximately 300 feet removed from the end of the jettu. It was built at a cost of £8,354 and was opened for trade in 1910.

Significance:

It was the first jetty in the area and Denial Bay township became the main urban centre because of it. Its decline came about when the railway reached Murat Bay, when the newly proclaimed township of Ceduna then took trade away from Denial Bay.

William McKenzie was born in Macclesfield in 1843 and took up 17,800 acres at Denial Bay in 1884. On a plaque nearby is eulogised that 'Mac' was a blacksmith, builder, harbour master and J.P. His slogan was "You can't grow wheat with your hands in your pockets". When he died, his property was divided into 11 farms.

Significance:

The remains of a property that was more like a village, having post office facilities, police station and a saddler's. The station was affectionately known as "Mac's Town".






