This was a watering spot for teams hauling ore along the gulf route from Burra to Port Wakefield. This was located near the "Two Mile" Rest House two miles from the end of the road. (See separate sheet - Rest house ruin). A depression in the ground fenced on either side marks the track from the "Two Mile" and the main road to this well, which provided a reliable water supply on the dry coastal plain.
