

Church of random coursed local limestone with dressed stonework quoins. Gable ended roof, formerly slate, now clad with corrugated galvanised iron. Ecclesiastical windows. Addition of side porch.

#### Historical Summary:

Land was granted by the Government for the purposes of a church in 1849. Sir H. E. Fox Young, Governor of the day, laid the foundation stone in 1850. Rev. Octavius Hammond was the first incumbent of the church in 1857. Prior to that, Archdeacon Hale came from Poonindie to conduct services. The church has 5 very fine stained glass windows in the form of memorials to Samuel F. Sison, John S. Brown and John Anderson.

#### Significance:

The oldest church on the Eyre Peninsula.



#### Historical Summary:

This is the second Police Station and Courthouse building. The tender of Birtwhistle and Francis for £1,088 was accepted in March 1862. The contract was completed by September 1862. The building is identical to the one built at Melrose.

#### Significance:

This building represented the Government's authority in the region.



The plaque of his grave reads 'Original gravesite of Francis Hawson who died of Aboriginal spear wounds, October 1840, aged 12. Reinterred at Hawson Reserve 30.3.1911. Plaque by Port Lincoln Pioneer and Descendant's Club.'

#### Historical Summary:

The plaque for this monument reads: 'Hawson, aged 10 years, who was speared by blacks, October 5th, 1840. Buried in Trafalgar Street 1840. Reinterred under this monument, March 30th, 1911. Although a lad, he died a hero. Gone but not forgotten.'

#### Significance:

The event of young Hawson's death has become an important element in folk history of the region.

Random coursed stone cottage with stone quoins. Hipped corrugated galvanised iron roof with stone chimney. Raked verandah with simple timber posts. Stone skillion and asbestos cement lean-to. Double hung sash windows.

#### Historical Summary:

It has been claimed that the house is associated with both the Owen and Walker family. The Walker family of Sophia and Robert Walker travelled to South Australia on the "Buffalo". Soon after arrival, Sophia's husband died, so she travelled to Port Lincoln with her son Henry to be a domestic servant. She eventually married James Owen who owned an early saddlers and the Pier Hotel.

#### Significance:

Loosely associated with a settler who was a passenger on the "Buffalo" in the first fleet to South Australia in 1836.



#### Historical Summary:

From about 1914 to the 1930s this school was used as a private boarding school for girls which was run by the Misses Thomas. Apparently a few boys attended too.

#### Significance:

As far as can be ascertained, this was the only private boarding school to exist on the Eyre Peninsula before the twentieth century.
