Description:

Cottage of rendered pine walls with wire netting reinforcement. Gable ended corrugated galvanised iron roof. Stone chimney and end wall. Raked verandahs with simple timber posts on two sides. Double hung sash windows.

Historical Summary:

This cottage was originally situated three miles out of Kimba, but was moved in 1974 to the Kimba Museum. The Hasket brothers came from the Mount Jagged area near Victor Harbor to take up this land. The cottage is the second dwelling to be built in the district.

The stone for the present building is reputed to be Port Lincoln Duck Pond stone which "is so soft that you can carve it with a pocket knife. After a time, it will harden on the outside and become waterproof". The contractor for this building also contracted the post office.
